Projects:

Technology for Africa- The Technology for Africa project aims to promote entrepreneurship around the world by providing residents in Douala and the Littoral Province in the central Africa country of Cameroon access to computers and training on how to use the computers for economic development purposes.

In March 2009, seven College of Charleston's SIFE students, a faculty advisor and one board member, traveled to Cameroon to set up three computer labs and teach entrepreneurship after successfully raising over \$64,000 for the project.

Bandage for Africa- Bandage for Africa is a project to send medical supplies to a medical university in Cameroon.

The project is in progress and we hope to deliver the supplies in 2010.

Micro-loans for Africa- Possibilities Without Borders is currently planning a micro-loan program to support students in Africa and help them start their own businesses.
